Traverse City Figure Skating Club Reopening Protocol

It is the goal of the club to provide a safe place for our members. We are doing everything we can to reduce the risk. As members coming to Centre ICE and joining figure skating club activities, the club is requiring the following:

Building Use

- Follow all Centre ICE protocols
- If you or anyone in your family is sick, showing any symptoms, or have knowingly been in contact with someone who has Covid-19 within the past 14 days, stay home.
- Social distancing
- Masks are not required but highly recommended for members in the building. It is not expected that skaters wear a mask while skating. Social distancing and wearing a mask is the best way to minimize transmission.
- The club locker room will be closed. Skaters are asked to arrive dressed. There will be benches in the lobby for skaters to put their skates on.
- Skaters are asked to warm up outside the building, or upstairs in the case of rain.
- Skaters are not to enter Centre ICE Arena more than 30 minutes ahead of their session.
- Only skaters preparing or waiting for the following session are allowed to wait in the downstairs lobby. Parents may watch from the stands or upstairs. Skaters may also watch from the stands or upstairs while waiting to be picked up if need be. Any skaters staying at Centre ICE Arena must be in the stands or in the upstairs lobby adhering to social distancing guidelines.
- Skaters are to bring their belongings from the lobby area into the rink when they are allowed to enter, and place their belongings at one of the benches that will be placed along the outside of the boards. When done with their session, they do not go back into the lobby. They may take their skates off at the bench in the arena and then either go to the stands or leave via the side door. The benches will be marked with an X where skaters may sit. Skaters may only reenter the lobby area to use the restroom.
- Skaters on the ice will place their water bottles etc. at one of the spots indicated by an X at the boards. This will be the only spot the skater can go to while at the boards. It is expected that the skaters will remain moving using counterclockwise patterns whenever possible.
- Boards will be cleaned between each session.
- All skaters will clear the ice during the 10 minute cleaning between sessions. If a skater is skating the following session they may reenter the lobby and wait there.
- Music is to be played only by the coaches
- The office will be closed to visitors. We will publish office hours weekly, where Kathy will be available either in the stands or in the ticket office.

Registration Changes

- All payments to the club are to be made via your EntryEeze account, or to the club Venmo account (no fees). When using Venmo, you must indicate what you are paying for, and have your cart reflecting the same.
- Sessions will be open for purchase up to 10 minutes before the start of each session

- Members are responsible for purchasing ice online via EE. Drop in rates apply after deadlines. The deadline is set for the Saturday (11:55pm) prior to the start of each week. From that time until the start of the session, a drop in rate will be charged.
- ONLY skaters who have paid and are waiting for their session to begin may be in the lobby.
- Switches are made online in the members EE account by the member. There is no fee to switch sessions. The session can be switched to any other session during the entire summer. There will be no vouchers. Members are responsible for their own session management.
- Sessions are limited to 12 skaters
- Parents of young children are encouraged to help their skater follow the guidelines while in the lobby waiting.
