Class Descriptions

There are eight levels in the program which will introduce the skater to the fundamentals of skating. The skater will work on forward and backward skating, stops, edges, crossovers, and many other skills. Each skater will receive an official USFS book explaining the required skating elements of each level. After mastering all of the elements within a level your skater will be tested and receive a badge for their accomplishment. Most of these classes consist of a 30-minute group lesson with an instructor and then a 20-minute bridge/practice time (see descriptions below)

Snowplow Sam 1

- For skaters ages 3-5 with little or no skating experience
- 30 -min group lesson with a number of instructors
- Learn basic balance and skating skills
- A fun introductory class in an age appropriate setting
- Helmet s are required

Basic 1-8

- For skaters ages 6 -11
- Learn the basic fundamentals of skating to begin Hockey, Freestyle Skating, and Speed skating
- Classes cover basic fundamental skating skills: forward, backward, glides, stops, edges, crossovers, turns, etc
- Skills build on each level as the skater progresses
- 30-min group lesson and 20-min practice time

Teen

- For skaters ages 12-17
- Skate with your friends while learning the basic fundamentals of skating
- 30-min group lesson and 20-min practice time

Junior Club

- Passed Basic 3 through low freestyle
- Skaters receive a 30-minute group instruction class and 20-minute practice time
- Class will include freestyle: jumps, spins, edge work, moves in the field
- Great way to join our figure skating club

Basic 1-8, Teen, Adult class with Private Lesson

- Must be in Basic 1 or above
- 10-min private lesson with one of our coaches during practice time after the group lesson
- Instructors will be on a rotation throughout the session
- Great way for your skater to stay focused during their practice time

Adult/Advanced Adult

- For skaters 18 and older
- Designed for mature skater interested in learning how to skate
- Classes are geared towards skaters ability
- 30-min group lesson and 20-min practice time

Common Questions Asked:

Q. What should my child wear?

A. Warm clothing (nothing bulky), gloves, hat,

Q. What if my child wants to play hockey?

A. The Basic skills classes are a great way to get started. Many hockey players have started with our program and have been successful hockey players.

Q. What to do when you arrive?

A. Sign in at the registration desk where you will receive a colored pass to get on the ice. Please arrive 15 minutes early to give your skater time to get ready and check in.

Q. If I am currently in Basic Skills, when do I join the figure skating club?

A. Skaters in Basic 4 or above who are interested in pursuing figure skating on a higher level are eligible to join the figure skating club. It is recommended that a skater reaches Junior Club &/or Advanced Beginner before they join the Traverse City Figure Skating Club and supplement their Learn to skate class with a private lesson.
